

## The Biblical Purpose of Baptism

<b>“shall be saved”</b>	<b>Mark 16:16</b> “He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.”
<b>“for the remission of sins”</b>	<b>Acts 2:38</b> “Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the
<b>“wash away your sins”</b>	<b>Acts 22:16</b> ‘And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.’
<b>“freed from sin”</b>	<b>Romans 6:7</b> “For he who has died has been freed from sin”
<b>“put on Christ”</b>	<b>Galatians 3:27</b> “For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ”
<b>“cleanse her with the washing of water”</b>	<b>Ephesians 5:26</b> “that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word”
<b>“putting off the sins of the flesh”</b>	<b>Colossians 2:11</b> “In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ”
<b>“having forgiven you all trespasses”</b>	<b>Colossians 2:13</b> “And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses”
<b>“baptism doth also now save us”</b>	<b>1 Peter 3:21</b> “There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ”
