**Now the names of the twelve apostles are these:**

## **Matthew 10:1-4**

And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.<sup>2</sup> Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother;

## **Mark 3:14-15**

"And He went up on the mountain and called to Him those He Himself wanted. And they came to Him.<sup>14</sup> Then He appointed twelve, that they might be with Him and that He might send them out to preach"

- 1 Simon, to whom He gave the name Peter
- 2 Andrew
- 3 James the son of Zebedee
- 4 John the brother of James, to whom He gave the name Boanerges, that is, ("Sons of Thunder")
- 5 Philip
- 6 Bartholomew
- 7 Thomas
- 8 Matthew
- 9 James the son of Alphaeus
- 10 Thaddaeus
- 11 Simon the Cananite
- 12 Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him

## **Luke 6:13-16**

" And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles:<sup>14</sup> Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew;<sup>15</sup> Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot;<sup>16</sup> Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor"

## **Acts 1:12-13**

Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey.<sup>13</sup> And when they had entered, they went up into the upper room where they were staying: Peter, James, John, and Andrew; Philip and Thomas; Bartholomew and Matthew; James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot; and Judas the son of James.
