Believe - won't Confess	<b>John 12:42</b> Nevertheless even among the rulers many believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they <b>did not confess Him</b> , lest they should be put out of the synagogue;
Weak Faith	<b>Romans 4:19</b> And not being <b>weak in faith</b> , he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb.
Dead Faith	<b>James 2:26</b> For as the body without the spirit is dead, so <b>faith without works is dead also.</b>
Little Faith	<b>Matthew 14:31</b> And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him (Peter), and said to him, "O you of <b>little faith</b> , why did you doubt?"
Doubting Faith	<b>Matthew 14:31</b> And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, <b>why did you doubt?</b> "
Fearful Faith	<b>Matthew 8:26</b> But He said to them, " <b>Why are you fearful, O you of little faith?</b> " Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm.
Erring Faith	<b>1 Timothy 6:10</b> For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have <b>strayed from the faith</b> in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
Denied Faith	<b>1 Timothy 5:8</b> But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has <b>denied the faith</b> and is worse than an unbeliever.
Shipwrecked Faith	<b>1 Timothy 1:19</b> having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the <b>faith have suffered shipwreck.</b>
