"Baptism doesn't save you"	"Baptism now saves you" (1 Peter 3:21)
"Bishop must be single"	"Bishop must be the husband of one wife" (1 Timothy 3:2)
"Can't fall from grace"	"You have fallen from grace" (Gal. 5:4)
"Married in heaven"	"In the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage" (Matthew 22:30)
"Inherit sins of parents"	"The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity" (Ezekiel 18:20).
"Stress love not commands"	"If you love Me you will keep My commandments" (John 14:15)
"Many people going to heaven"	"Few" (Matthew 7:13-14)
"As long as you are sincere"	"Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord, will enter the kingdom of heaven: but he who does the will of My Father" (Matthew 7:21)
"All faiths lead to heaven"	"There is... one faith" (Ephesians 4:5)
"God will save unbelievers"	"dealing out retribution to those who do not God and those who do not obey the gospel" (2 Thessalonians 1:8).
"Hell isn't eternal"	"eternal destruction" (2 Thessalonians 1:9)
