PROPHECY	WHERE	FULFILLED
That He would be born of a Virgin:	Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel."	Matthew 1:23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."
To be born in Bethlehem:	Micah 5:2 "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting."	Matthew 2:5-6 "So they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it is written by the prophet: 6 'But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, 1 Are not the least among the rulers of Judah; For out of you shall come a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel.' "
To be called a Nazarene:	Matthew 2:23 "And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, "He shall be called a Nazarene."	Acts 22:8 "So I (Paul) answered, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said to me, 'I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom you are persecuting.'
To be betrayed by a friend:	Psalm 41:9 "Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me"	John 13:18 "I do not speak concerning all of you. I know whom I have chosen; but that the Scripture may be fulfilled, 'He who eats bread with Me has lifted up his heel against Me.'
That He would die for our transgressions:	Isaiah 53:8 "He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.	Philippians 2:8 "And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross"
That He would be raised from the dead:	Isaiah 53:10 "Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand.	Romans 8:32 "He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" (See Romans 3:25, 5:6; 1 John 2:2; 1 John 4:10 etc)

<p>That He would be betrayed for thirty pieces of silver:</p>	<p>Zechariah 11:12 "Then I said to them, "If it is agreeable to you, give me my wages; and if not, refrain." So they weighed out for my wages thirty pieces of silver"</p>	<p>Matthew 26:15 and said, "What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?" And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver'</p>
<p>That His garment would be parted by casting lots:</p>	<p>Psalm 22:18 "They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots"</p>	<p>John 19:23-24 Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece.²⁴ They said therefore among themselves, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be," that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says: ¹ "They divided My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots." Therefore the soldiers did these things'</p>

<p>A descendent of David. (II Sam. 7:12; Matt. 22:43-44)</p>	<p>2 Samuel 7:12 "When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, I will set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom"</p>	<p>Matthew 22:43-44 He said to them, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying: ⁴⁴ 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" " "</p>
<p>Called the Son of God:</p>	<p>Psalm 2:7 "I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.</p>	<p>Matthew 16:16-18 "Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."¹⁷ Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.¹⁸ "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it"</p>
